METALWORK

Our approach to cabinetry is simple: allow our *expertise in metalwork* to break convention and *celebrate it as a defining element*—flowing through and across the cabinet in the *perfect ratio of metal to wood*.

With a legacy in crafting exceptional metal fittings, we use our knowledge to inform every detail of our cabinetry. We approach each design with the belief that metal should not merely embellish but define. Instead of treating it as an accent, we make metal integral to the architecture, piercing through doors and spanning entire elevations to create striking visual through-lines. Each of our four collections interprets this integration in its own way, conveying the kind of definitive statement that only comes from years of expertise in design and making.

Drawing from broadly ranging and carefully considered inspiration, our in-house design team puts pen to paper. Hand drawing isn't just how we start an idea—it's how we translate it, capturing movement, proportion, and purpose. Every line matters. Every curve and joint connects to a larger architectural language.

These first sketches turn imagination into intention, refined through constant collaborative conversations across our team. From there, we build material boards—layered with wood stains, metal finishes, surfaces, and tonal studies. They guide our choices, showing how each element will work together in a space, not as stand-alone pieces but as part of a cohesive experience of warmth, luxury, and utility.



HAND DRAWING

Skilled US cabinetmakers and British metalwork fabricators evolve our hand sketches into 3D models, renderings, and prototypes. Prototypes bring our designs into the physical world—allowing us to test how they look, feel, and function. We touch, adjust, and refine until every decision meets our exacting standards. Only then do we begin production.

Marrying two materials with fundamentally different natures—wood that moves with the environment and metal that remains dimensionally stable—demands practiced skill and precise engineering. Each channel for the metal inlay is precisely machined into the wood, then hand-refined to accommodate subtle variations in the metal's thickness or size. Every piece is inspected, shaped, and set to sit perfectly flush within the wood.



WOOD FINISHING

All of this is completed within the controlled environment of our cabinetmaker—never on-site—where the accuracy, patience, and skill required can be fully achieved. This labor-intensive process calls for extraordinary patience, a steady hand, and an unerring eye for detail—hallmarks of craftsmanship that elevate every cabinet into a singular work of art.

Each project is inherently unique, shaped by the architecture of its setting and the people who inhabit it. From site visits to detailed renderings and elevations, we tailor every design to suit the proportions and character of the space. In close collaboration with our clients, we select finishes, woods, and colors—ensuring that every detail reflects a shared vision. The cabinetry we create becomes a deeply personal expression of both place and individuality, brought to life through uncompromising craftsmanship. Our commitment continues well beyond installation, with trusted partners and ongoing support that ensure your cabinetry endures beautifully over time.



HAND-APPLIED METALWORK

The result is cabinetry that feels inevitable—crafted, not manufactured. *Wood and metal aren't simply paired, but fully integrated.* Metalwork isn't an afterthought; it's a defining element.
